Refund Terms, Assumption of Risk & Liability Waiver

W.A.W.A. 2027 Rest, Wellness & Reflection Getaway

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ BEFORE REGISTERING OR MAKING A PAYMENT

This policy is part of the registration agreement for the W.A.W.A. 2027 Rest, Wellness & Reflection Getaway. By registering, paying a deposit or installment, checking the online acceptance box, or signing below, the participant confirms that she has read, understood, and voluntarily agrees to all terms in this document.

KEY TERMS AT A GLANCE

- \$100 reservation deposit is non-refundable.
- Installment payments are generally non-refundable.
- At least 30 days written notice is required to request a participant replacement.
- No-show, late cancellation, or early departure does not qualify for a refund.
- The liability waiver applies only to the fullest extent permitted by law.

1. Agreement, Scope, and Definitions

This Full Cancellation Policy, Refund Terms, Assumption of Risk, and Liability Waiver (the "Policy") governs all registrations, reservations, payments, cancellations, transfers, attendance, and participation in the W.A.W.A. 2027 Rest, Wellness & Reflection Getaway (the "Getaway") hosted by Women Aligned With Abundance Inc. ("W.A.W.A.," "we," "us," or "our"). "Participant" means the registered attendee and, where applicable, her parent or legal guardian.

2. Reservation and Non-Refundable Deposit

- A reservation is not complete until W.A.W.A. receives the completed registration form, the required \$100 deposit, and the participant's acceptance of this Policy.
- The \$100 deposit is non-refundable and is applied toward the participant's selected retreat package balance.
- Room selection and space are subject to availability and are not guaranteed until payment clears and W.A.W.A. confirms registration in writing or by email.
- Returned, disputed, reversed, or declined payments may result in loss of the reservation. Any bank, card, or payment-processing fees charged to W.A.W.A. because of the participant's payment activity may be added to the participant's balance where permitted by law.

3. Installment Payments and Remaining Balance

- Installment payments are due according to the payment schedule selected during registration or otherwise approved by W.A.W.A. in writing.
- Payment reminders are a courtesy. The participant remains responsible for tracking and paying all amounts by the stated deadlines.
- Unless this Policy specifically provides otherwise, installment payments are non-refundable because W.A.W.A. may immediately commit funds to hotel rooms, vendors, supplies, programming, and other non-recoverable event expenses.
- A missed or incomplete payment may result in cancellation of the reservation after notice from W.A.W.A. Any reinstatement is discretionary and depends on space, vendor deadlines, and full payment of the outstanding balance.

4. Cancellation by the Participant

All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to wawainc24@gmail.com. A cancellation is effective only when W.A.W.A. confirms receipt in writing.

- 30 days or more before May 13, 2027: The participant may request permission to transfer the reservation to an eligible replacement participant. There is no automatic right to a cash refund.
- Fewer than 30 days before May 13, 2027: All amounts paid may be forfeited, and W.A.W.A. is not required to issue a refund, credit, or transfer.

- No-show or early departure: No refund or credit will be provided for failure to attend, late arrival, missed activities, voluntary withdrawal, removal for misconduct, or departure before the Getaway ends.
- Personal circumstances: Illness, work conflicts, family emergencies, transportation problems, weather at the participant's departure location, or a change of plans do not automatically create a right to a refund. Travel insurance is strongly recommended.

5. Replacement Participant and Reservation Transfer

- The cancelling participant is responsible for identifying a suitable replacement. W.A.W.A. is not responsible for locating one.
- Every replacement must be approved by W.A.W.A., complete a new registration, accept this Policy, satisfy rooming and eligibility requirements, and pay any remaining balance by the deadline provided.
- A transfer is not complete until W.A.W.A. confirms it in writing. Reservations may not be sold, auctioned, assigned, divided, or transferred without written approval.
- Amounts already paid may be applied to an approved replacement only to the extent W.A.W.A. can reasonably reassign the reservation and vendor commitments. Non-recoverable costs remain non-refundable.

6. Refund Review and Processing

- A request for a refund does not guarantee approval. W.A.W.A. will evaluate requests under this Policy, applicable law, vendor contracts, and the circumstances existing at the time of cancellation.
- Approved refunds will be issued to the original payment method whenever practical. Processing may take up to 30 business days after written approval, depending on payment processors and financial institutions.
- Any approved refund may be reduced by non-recoverable third-party charges, payment-processing costs that are not returned to W.A.W.A., chargeback fees, or other amounts the participant owes, but only where permitted by law.
- The participant agrees not to initiate a chargeback for a valid, authorized payment merely because the participant changed plans or disagrees with this Policy. This does not waive any rights that cannot lawfully be waived.

7. Cancellation, Postponement, Relocation, or Modification by W.A.W.A.

- W.A.W.A. may reasonably modify schedules, speakers, facilitators, activities, meals, vendors, hotel arrangements, or other program details when necessary. Comparable substitutions do not automatically qualify for a refund.
- If W.A.W.A. cancels the entire Getaway for reasons within its reasonable control, W.A.W.A. will refund retreat payments received directly from the participant, less any separately authorized and non-refundable third-party purchases that cannot be recovered.
- If W.A.W.A. postpones or relocates the Getaway, amounts paid will ordinarily be transferred to the rescheduled or replacement event. W.A.W.A. will communicate available credit or refund options based on vendor obligations and applicable law.
- W.A.W.A. is not responsible for the participant's airfare, ground transportation, additional lodging, missed wages, childcare, personal purchases, or other incidental or consequential expenses, even when the Getaway is changed or cancelled.

8. Force Majeure and Events Beyond W.A.W.A.'s Control

W.A.W.A. is not liable for delay, interruption, relocation, postponement, reduction, or cancellation caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including severe weather, natural disaster, fire, flood, epidemic, pandemic, public-health order, war, terrorism, civil disturbance, labor dispute, utility or transportation failure, government action, venue closure, supplier failure, or similar emergency (a "Force Majeure Event").

- W.A.W.A. may reschedule, relocate, shorten, modify, or provide substitute programming in response to a Force Majeure Event.
- Any refund or credit following a Force Majeure Event will be limited to amounts W.A.W.A. actually recovers or retains after paying non-refundable hotel, vendor, venue, and administrative commitments, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- W.A.W.A. will make reasonable efforts to communicate material changes, but it does not guarantee uninterrupted access to email, internet, transportation, or venue services during an emergency.

9. Hotel, Travel, and Independent Third Parties

- Unless expressly stated in writing, the participant is responsible for arranging and paying for transportation to and from Atlantic City and for all personal expenses.
- The hotel, resort, restaurants, transportation providers, facilitators, entertainers, contractors, and other vendors are independent third parties. W.A.W.A. does not control and is not responsible for their separate policies, acts, omissions, cancellations, delays, property conditions, or service failures.
- The published retreat price does not include the hotel's \$25 per-day resort fee and applicable taxes, which are payable directly to the hotel at check-in, unless W.A.W.A. later confirms different terms in writing.

- Participants must follow all hotel, venue, transportation, and vendor rules. Separate vendor waivers or terms may also apply.

10. Assumption of Risk

The participant understands that travel and retreat participation involve known and unknown risks, including slips, falls, food reactions, illness exposure, transportation incidents, weather, crime, property loss, physical exertion, emotional discomfort during reflective activities, and acts or omissions of other participants or third parties.

- Participation in workshops, movement, wellness, reflection, group activities, excursions, or optional programs is voluntary.
- The participant accepts responsibility for evaluating her own physical, mental, and emotional ability to participate and for choosing not to participate in any activity that feels unsafe or inappropriate.
- The participant knowingly and voluntarily assumes the ordinary risks associated with travel, hotel stays, group gatherings, and Getaway activities.

11. Release and Waiver of Liability

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, the participant releases, waives, and agrees not to sue Women Aligned With Abundance Inc. and its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, representatives, contractors, sponsors, affiliates, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "Released Parties") for claims, losses, damages, liabilities, or expenses arising from or related to the participant's attendance, travel, lodging, use of facilities, or participation in the Getaway, including claims caused by the ordinary negligence of a Released Party.

This release does not apply to gross negligence, reckless conduct, intentional or willful misconduct, fraud, or any liability or legal right that cannot lawfully be waived. Nothing in this Policy waives rights provided by mandatory consumer-protection or other applicable law.

12. Health, Medical Care, and Emergency Assistance

- W.A.W.A. does not provide medical, psychological, psychiatric, dietary, or therapeutic diagnosis or treatment. Retreat content is educational and supportive and is not a substitute for professional care.
- The participant is responsible for consulting an appropriate healthcare professional before participating when she has a medical condition, pregnancy, injury, allergy, disability, dietary concern, or other health-related limitation.
- In an emergency, the participant authorizes W.A.W.A. personnel to contact emergency services and the participant's emergency contact. The participant is responsible for all medical, transportation, medication, and related costs.
- W.A.W.A. does not guarantee an allergen-free environment or that every dietary request can be accommodated.

13. Personal Property and Financial Responsibility

- The participant is solely responsible for money, identification, electronics, luggage, medication, jewelry, clothing, vehicles, and other personal property.
- The Released Parties are not responsible for lost, stolen, damaged, misplaced, or unattended property, except to the extent liability cannot lawfully be excluded.
- The participant is financially responsible for damage she causes to hotel property, event property, vendor property, or another person's property, as well as unauthorized room charges or fines assessed because of her conduct.

14. Participant Conduct and Removal

- Participants must behave respectfully and may not engage in harassment, threats, violence, illegal activity, disruptive conduct, unsafe behavior, excessive intoxication, or conduct that materially interferes with the Getaway or the safety and comfort of others.
- W.A.W.A. may remove a participant from an activity or the Getaway when W.A.W.A. reasonably believes removal is necessary for safety, legal compliance, hotel requirements, or the well-being of the group.
- A participant removed for misconduct is not entitled to a refund or reimbursement and remains responsible for her return transportation, alternative lodging, and related expenses.

15. Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the participant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the Released Parties harmless from third-party claims, damages, losses, judgments, penalties, and reasonable costs arising from the participant's unlawful conduct, intentional misconduct, material breach of this Policy, damage to property, or injury caused by the participant. This provision does not require the participant to indemnify a Released Party for that party's gross negligence, reckless conduct, or willful misconduct.

16. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, W.A.W.A.'s total direct liability arising from the Getaway or this Policy will not exceed the amount the participant actually paid directly to W.A.W.A. for the Getaway. W.A.W.A. will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, punitive, or consequential damages, including lost income, lost opportunities, travel expenses, or emotional distress, except where such limitation is prohibited by law.

17. Travel Insurance

W.A.W.A. strongly recommends that participants purchase travel insurance that may cover trip cancellation, illness, transportation disruption, emergency medical expenses, lost luggage, and other unexpected events. W.A.W.A. does not sell, select, or guarantee any insurance policy and is not responsible for coverage decisions or claim outcomes.

18. Good-Faith Resolution, Governing Law, and Venue

- Before filing a legal claim, the participant and W.A.W.A. agree to attempt in good faith to resolve the dispute through written notice and direct discussion for at least 30 days, unless immediate relief is legally necessary.
- This Policy is governed by the laws of the State of Connecticut, without regard to conflict-of-law rules, except to the extent mandatory law of another jurisdiction applies.
- Any court proceeding arising from this Policy or the Getaway must be filed in a state or federal court with jurisdiction in or serving Fairfield County, Connecticut, unless applicable law requires another venue.

19. Severability, Entire Agreement, and No Waiver

- If any provision is found invalid or unenforceable, it will be modified to the minimum extent necessary or removed, and the remaining provisions will continue in effect.
- This Policy, the registration form, the confirmed payment schedule, and any written event-specific terms provided by W.A.W.A. form the complete agreement on cancellation, refunds, risk, and liability. Conflicting oral statements are not binding.
- A delay or failure by W.A.W.A. to enforce a provision on one occasion is not a waiver of that provision or the right to enforce it later.
- W.A.W.A. may update this Policy before registration. The version accepted by the participant at the time of registration controls unless the participant later agrees to an updated version.

20. Electronic Acceptance and Copies

The participant agrees that an electronic checkbox, typed name, digital signature, online payment submitted after disclosure of this Policy, or handwritten signature may serve as her legal acceptance of this Policy. The participant may request or save an electronic copy for her records.
